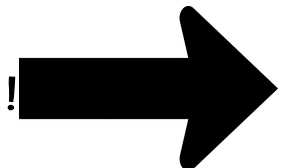

## Grub Club

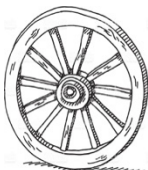
While in Grub Club, you get to sit with a friend for the week and eat (mostly healthy) all day long.

 Check in is at 8:05 in the morning.

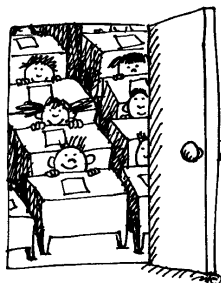
START:

5. Ask permission for pencil sharpener use.



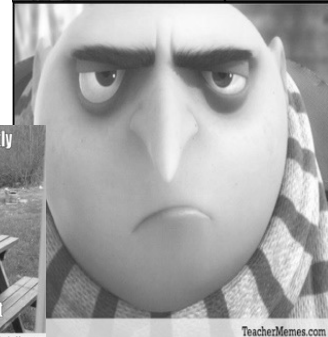
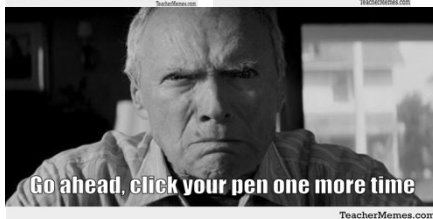
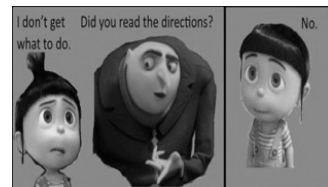
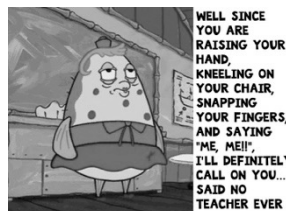
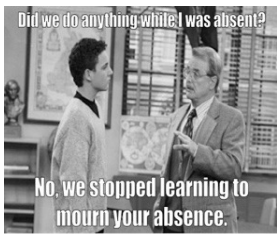
# END-OF-DAY/DISMISSAL
